Membership – Approval of Membership Minutes from NACAC (Boston). Minutes on page 29 of conference booklet. After review, minutes were approved.

Recognized Sara Ringe and Charlie Hungerford as membership chairs. We currently have 678 members. Moved from institutional to individual memberships this past fall. Our membership revenue was \$17,710.

NACAC is changing structure for membership. We will mirror whatever changes are necessary to stay in line with them.

<u>Admission Practices</u> - Recognized Charlie Hungerford as Admissions Practices chair. Minimal complaints this year.

<u>**College Fairs</u>**- List of fairs is provided on your table. Jamie Staggs is our college fair co-chair. Jamie has worked to target specific regions of the state. We have trimmed the overall number of fairs in a way to maximize reps' time as well as students' experience. We will have 10 regional fairs this fall (up from 6 this past fall). A spring fair will be held at KC at UMKC on April 15, 2018. STL regional fair is at Maryville University on April 22. We are currently at 64 for KC and over 120 for STL.</u>

<u>Government Relations</u> – Kyle Strothmann is our chair. Members of exec board met with several congressmen and women in Washington DC in February to discuss various agendas.

<u>**Treasurer's Report</u>** – Liz Majors is our current treasurer and Kyle Strothmann is our past treasurer. We will be choosing a treasurer-elect for this next cycle. We have had a strong fiscal showing this year. \$133,335 in checking and now \$237,760 as of March this year. Money market from last year</u>

\$65,084 and this year is \$130,019. To date, MOACAC has had about a \$20,000 increase. (After paying out costs for conference. For conference, we will turn a profit for this year. This is due to conference planners being very diligent in costs.
